"KMT" or Kemet was one of the original names of the region of Africa currently viewed as Egypt. In addition, peoples that would be considered, in today's terminology, "phenotypically" of African progeny, inhabited the region, according to extensive research.

Participation consisted of an intense two (2) week study of the ancient culture, ethics, and political structure of the civilization. The study tour involved visiting various tombs, temples, and monuments in order to compile information for later discussions, research, and presentations. Dr. Hilliard, III also provided evening lectures.
